Raritan River Rain Barrel Rebate Program Rebates of up to \$200 to install rain barrels at your home!

A rain barrel collects and stores rainwater from a roof that would otherwise be runoff diverted into storm drains, streets, or streams. Rain barrels can be used to water garden plants, lawns, wash cars, and other non-potable uses.

The New Jersey Water Supply Authority is partnering with The Regional Center Partnership and Manville Borough to offer rebates for residents in Manville, Bridgewater, Raritan, and Somerville to install rain barrels at their homes. All of these areas drain to the Raritan River, a source of drinking water. Rain Barrels are a great way to help to reduce runoff and improve water quality!

<u>\$50</u> may be awarded for installed barrels that hold 40-70 gallons, while <u>\$100</u> may be reimbursed for each barrel holding over 70 gallons. Each residential property is eligible for rebates on up to 2 rain barrels.



After a successful application and rain barrel inspection, residents of Manville will have their rebates processed through Manville Borough, while Bridgewater, Raritan, and Somerville rebates will be processed through The Regional Center Partnership.
